Dear Sir

Enclosed I beg to hand invoice of 7 packages put on board the Honorable Company's Ship Prince of Wales to your address, which I trust will reach you safe.

The amount of the shipment, say £ 36.3., has been passed to your account, leaving a balance of [?] in my favor as of Statement at foot.

Awing to the prosperous state of the country, and the working classes having plenty of employment there has been a great demand for articles of general condition during the past 12 months and I have been obliged to give higher prices than usual for some of the goods. The shipment has, however, been made as advantageously as I could manage it.
