INTRODUCTION

The literature of World Communism is so enormous that no attempt has ever been made to catalogue it. Bibliographies dealing with special subjects in this field are often incomplete because of the elusive nature of the pamphlet material involved. This collection of about a thousand scarce pamphlets includes many items which document a number of important topics in world communism upon which little research has been carried out - precisely because so little of this material has been available even in the largest libraries. It is particularly rich in pamphlets published in Albania, China's sole ally in Europe and in East Germany which despite the growing acceptance of the regime in the West, remains an enigma.

Also of great current interest is a large number of pamphlets of the British Communist Party and its allies. The Communist Party of Great Britain, while negligible as a political force, nevertheless retains great influence in the trade-union movement, particularly in the key engineering industry.

The Sino-Soviet dispute is highlighted in a large number of documents, which reflect the divisions of contradictions now existing within the Communist world. The viewpoint of Hanoi, rarely heard in the Western world, is also largely featured here.

Some of the more important 'classical' but lesser known Communist writers like Rosa Luxemburg, De Leon, etc., are included, as well as many of the shorter and more elusive works of Marx, Engels, Lenin and Stalin.

This collection would provide invaluable source material for any serious student of world communism. This, in the sort of depth which would be impossible other than with a mass of pamphlets assembled in this way so richly illustrating the more uncommon viewpoints on the subject.
