1. Published biographical data with details added by Dr. Matthews, and a covering letter to Dr. L.A. Pagliaro. May 12, 1980.
2. Correspondence chiefly between Dean G.A. Burbidge (Halifax) and Dean E.L. Woods (Saskatchewan) regarding the upgrading of the diploma course in pharmacy. September 29, 1927 - August 23, 1939. An explanatory note from Dr. Matthews is included.
3. Correspondence regarding raising the standards of pharmaceutical education in Canada. October 4, 1932 - September 5, 1933. Includes printed report of the Committee of Education, August 1926, and a covering letter from Dr. Matthews.
4. Correspondence pertaining to the first meeting of the Canadian Conference of Pharmaceutical Faculties in August 1944. February 4, 1944 - November 2, 1944. Includes comments on the proposed Committee of Education, and a copy of the recommendations of the Conference.
5. Agenda, proposed constitution and bylaws, text of two speeches by Dr. Matthews and questionnaire of the Canadian Conference of Pharmaceutical Faculties. August 14 - 15, 1944. Includes comments made by other university pharmacists (1939-1940)
6. Correspondence from President Robert C. Wallace and the Bursar regarding the Carnegie Corporation Research grant for a graduate student. March 25, 1935 - November 5, 1935. Includes a letter from President Wallace stating the budget for the pharmacy department. April 1935 to March 1936.
7. Correspondence about the funding and use of funds in the Medicinal Plant Research projects at the U. of A. March 25, 1935 - May 29, 1943. Contains 3 newsclippings regarding the success of growing belladonna.

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8. Correspondence among members and chairman of the Code of Ethics Committee of the Canadian Pharmaceutical Association.
September 20, 1935 - May 1, 1936.
Includes several copies of proposed codes of ethics and an explanatory note from Dr. Matthews.
9. Correspondence from former students seeking letters of recommendation or information on special courses.
February 18, 1941 - February 23, 1946.
Includes notes of identification by Dr. Matthews.
10. Reports of editor (A.W. Matthews), the Executive Committee and the Sub-committee of the Canadian Formulary.
1946 - April 4, 1949.
Includes an explanatory letter from Dr. Matthews.

Included is a review of drug controls and the development of The Canadian Formulary by Dr. Matthews.
