N/A	4	Bruce Peel - Framed Portrait	Item consists of one 19" by 15" framed portrait of Bruce Peel wearing academic regalia. Bruce Peel was the Chief Librarian at the University of Alberta from 1955 to 1982. During his tenure Bruce Peel created Peel's Prairie Provinces, a resource dedicated to assisting scholars, students, and researchers of all types in their exploration of western Canadian history and the culture of the Canadian prairies.
