PREFACE

The University of Alberta Archives was established in 1968 at the recommendation of the President's Standing Committee on Archives and Documents. Its primary mandate is to acquire, maintain, and preserve the records of the University, in any medium, which contain continuing administrative, legal, and historical value. The Archives constitutes the official "memory" of the University and represents the accumulated experience of our education community. In addition to these official records, the University Archives also contains the private papers of the University Staff whose subjects of research and teaching encompass the world.

INTRODUCTION

The black and white photographic negatives and proof sheets described in this inventory were created by the University of Alberta Students' Union Photo Directorate during the 1967/68 academic year. They form part of a larger series held by the University Archives dating from 1954 to 1985. It was from amongst these photos that most illustrations for *Gateway*, the Students' Union newspaper, and *Evergreen and Gold*, the yearbook, were selected. Documenting all facets of student activities on campus, the photos provide a detailed "snap shot" of student life during 1967/68.

Source: The photographs in this collection were donated to the University Archives by the Students' Union Photo Directorate in two accessions. The proof sheets formed a part of Accession 69-19, received via the Rare Book Library on 4 March, 1969, while the negatives were donated on 15 September, 1969 as Accession 69-109. For convenience of access these have been amalgamated as Accession 69-109.

Access: The records are open for research.

Extent: .54m.; approximately 15,000 images.

Date Range: 1967-1968

Physical Condition: Generally the negatives are in good physical condition having been housed in glassine negative files, and having received minimal handling beyond the initial purpose for which they were created. No obvious signs of serious physical deterioration were noted. The negatives have been placed in mylar sleeves. While they are certainly adequate for reference purposes, some of the proofs are in less than satisfactory physical condition. They show evidence of heavier use such as tattered corners, scratching, and editors, marks in various inks on the face of the photos. The proof sheets are stored in acid free envelopes.

ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY

Governed by the Universities Act, the University of Alberta Students' Union was established in 1908. It is an organization composed of students of the University and its affiliated colleges and schools, and includes all societies, clubs, and associations established under the authority of the Union's constitution. The Union provides for the administration of the affairs of the students at the University, including the development and management of student institutions and the promotion of the general welfare of students consistent with the purposes of the University. The Students' Council is the legislative, administrative, and executive body of the Union.¹

Over the years the Students' Union has produced two major publications, the student newspaper, *Gateway* (1908-), and the student yearbook, *Evergreen and Gold* (1921-1971). Photography is an important feature in both publications. In order to coordinate the photographic demands of these and other Union publications, during the 1947/48 academic year the Publications Photography Directorate was established. The director of photography, Bob Cook, was appointed by a three person board consisting of the Director of the Yearbook, the Editor-in-Chief of the *Gateway*, and the President of the Camera Club. The staff was comprised of a Director, an Assistant Director and from six to ten volunteer student photographers.²

By 1967/68, the year under consideration here, the list of photographers had grown to thirty-nine under the management of Director, Neil Driscoll. By this time the unit had become known, as it is today, as the Photo Directorate. As an indication of the quality of work produced by the Directorate, in 1967/68 the *Gateway* was awarded the Montreal Star Trophy for excellence in student newspaper photography.

ARRANGEMENT NOTE

The photographic records described in this inventory were received by the University Archives in two parts. The proof sheets were donated as part of Accession 69-19, and the negatives came separately and were assigned Accession 69-109. Both have now been subsumed under 69-109.

Upon arrival at the Archives the negatives, 35mm. and 60mm. black and white, were arranged roughly chronologically according to a registration number assigned by the Photo Directorate. As each photographer completed a photo assignment each roll of negatives would be placed into a separate glassine negative file upon which was written identifying information (subject, date, photographer, etc.). Each file was assigned a unique sequential number, which was also logged in a register. In most cases, a proof sheet, a contact print on which the positive image is the same size as the original negative, was produced for each file. The proof sheet was assigned the same registration number as the negative file. These were then arranged numerically in standard file folders, with a maximum of ten to a folder.

While physically rearranging the photos into a subject arrangement was briefly considered, it was soon apparent that such an arrangement would be physically impossible as well as theoretically undesirable. Since each negative file could cover more than one subject, a physical rearrangement would have required cutting negative strips and proof sheets, to separate out the subjects, a totally unsatisfactory notion. Clearly the original order, which is perfectly workable, would have to be retained.

A previous inventory had been prepared, arranged topically, for Accession 69-19, and it was considered desirable for the present inventory to harmonize with that one which covers photographs from the same series. From a reference perspective, enhanced subject access to the photos was necessary, since topical requests for photographs predominate over chronological or other approaches. Hence it was decided to retain the original order physically, but to intellectually arrange the subjects on paper in the inventory.

Each subject within each negative file was described separately. Therefore if a file contained negatives documenting three different topics, three entries for that file will appear in the inventory. The entries have been organized into four broad topical subseries, patterned after those in the earlier finding aid: Clubs, Events, and Departments; Sports; Campus and Buildings; and People. Within each subseries the order of entries is alphabetical, and then, where necessary, numerical by photo number. The Photo Directorate's original numbering scheme has been retained, dropping only the prefix denoting year which is replaced by the Archives accession number. For, example, Photo Directorate file 67-284 becomes 69-109-284 in the Archives. In order to further enhance access a name/subject index is found at the end of the inventory.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This series consists of black and white 35mm. and 60mm. photographic negatives, and positive proof sheets, created by the University of Alberta Students' Union Photo Directorate during the 1967/68 academic year. There are approximately 15,000 images in the collection. A few 4 x 5 prints are contained in the proof sheets but no corresponding negatives have been found. The work of 39 photographers is represented here, and it was from amongst these photos that photographs for publication in the *Evergreen and Gold*, the *Gateway* and its Friday supplement *Casserole*, were selected.

As a whole this collection provides a detailed overview of student activities at the University of Alberta during 1967/68. They document all facets of student life - sports, culture, residence life, clubs, events, student government, social concerns, recreation, academics, entertainment, and much more. The 1960s were turbulent times on many university campuses in North America, and these influences were felt at the University of Alberta as well. These photos document such issues as birth control, hippies, anti-Vietnam War demonstrations, mini skirts, drugs, and other controversial topics of the time.

This inventory is arranged in the following four subseries:

Clubs, Events, and Departments:

This is the largest and most complex of the subseries. Included here are photographs of events and activities sponsored by a broad range of student clubs, fraternities, and organizations, as well as candid shots documenting activities in various university faculties and departments. Some of the predominant topics found here are: Bar None; Bathtub Race; Commerce Rodeo; Concerts; Dances; Demonstrations; Drama; Engineering Week; Fraternities; Freshman Introduction Week; *Gateway*; Open Heart Surgery; Residence Life; Treasure Van; and Varsity Guest Weekend. The entries in this subseries are arranged alphabetically by subject, then numerically by photo number.

Sports:

The photos in this subseries document all manner of sporting activity at the University of Alberta, ranging from archery to wrestling. The emphasis is upon the major intercollegiate sports - football, basketball and hockey. Besides covering home games, Photo Directorate photographers travelled with the teams to out-of-town games, so they are represented as well. While official university teams predominate, some coverage is given to intramurals and recreational sports. Mug shots of some teams are found here, as are some shots of fan trips to out-of-town games. The entries in these subseries are arranged alphabetically by sport, then numerically by photo number.

Campus and Buildings:

This subseries consists of photos of various university buildings, as well as general views of the campus. While exterior shots of buildings predominate, interiors are also represented. Of particular note is a series of interior shots of the newly-opened Students' Union Building (SUB). The entries in this sub series are arranged alphabetically by building name, then numerically by photo number. General views of campus are found under "Campus".

People:

This subseries contains photos of individuals, chiefly students or faculty members, associated with the University of Alberta. Members of student government, various campus queens, and some distinguished visitors to campus are represented here, as are a number of candid shots of unidentified students. The entries in this subseries are arranged alphabetically by surname or subject term, then numerically by photo number.

Each entry within the inventory contains the following elements:

- Photo number: This is the unique number used to identify a particular photo file within the collection. For retrieval purposes the accession number should be added to the front of the photo number (e.g. 69-109-455).
- Title: This denotes the subject of the photographs. It can be either a name (ie. of an event, organization, or person), or a subject term created by the archivist (e.g. Dance, Concert, Campus, Students).
- Description: This elaborates on the title, providing additional details about the photographs.
- Photographer: This is the surname of the photographer as recorded on the original negative file. For full names of photographers refer to the *List of Photographers* on p. x of this inventory.
- Size: This denotes the size of film used - 35mm., 60mm., or 4" x 5".
- Number of images: This indicates the number of negatives covered by the entry.
- Proofs: Most items in this collection do include proof sheets, but some do not. In the latter case the notation "No proof" is made. Occasionally the number of images on a proof sheet is different than the number of negatives in the file. That information is recorded in this area. Similarly, there are a few proof sheets for which no negatives are found, in which case a notation of "Proof only, no negatives" is made.

Date: This date, taken from the original negative file, indicates the date on which the negatives were logged in the Photo Directorate register. While this is usually the date upon which the photos were taken, this is not always the case. The *Gateway* can usually be used to verify the date of a particular event.
